Group Mythology Presentation 30 Points

Students have been placed in six groups and will choose one mythical story from the list below to serve as the focus of the assignment. Groups are responsible for creating a dramatic production of the mythical story they have chosen. The dramatic production can take the following forms:

- A puppet show
- An in-class dramatic production
- An cartoon drawn with the aid of a free online animation site

Projects will be graded using the following rubric:

The stories below can be found in Edith Hamilton's *Mythology* (though that book is not the only source of information), and they are listed below:

- Prometheus
- Demeter and Persephone
- The Judgment of Paris
- Daedalus and Icarus
- Pandora
- Midas
- Heracles (Greek name for Hercules – you may choose a single Heracles story)
- Psyche and Eros
- Orpheus and Eurydice

Class time will be provided to work on this project, but it may also require groups to get together outside of class as well.
